Bhutan also known locally as DRUKYUL (Land of Thunder Dragon) has remained sequestered from the rest of the world in its pristine state, unspoiled by outside influences. Bordered by China (Tibet) in the North and India in the south, the kingdom of the Lost Horizon opened its door to tourism only in 1974, since then the number of visitors to Bhutan has steadily increased. Bhutan is endowed with breathtaking natural beauty, surrounded by sacred mountains, virgin peaks and holy lakes. Its 46,500 square kilometer of area is covered with not less than 72% of dense forest and jungles. In less than 65 miles, Bhutan rises 25,000 feet from the subtropical jungles of the south to arctic cold of



the high Himalayas. More than 90% of the population are farmers who live in small villages spread over rugged mountain. Since 8th century the Mahayana Buddhist teachings and philosophy played vital role in shaping the country's culture and their way of life. In fact, it is the only surviving Mahayana Buddhist Kingdom in the world.

Travelers to Bhutan will experience the enchantment of the pure and exotic land, through its ancient fortresses, monasteries, and temples that dot the countryside. With its imposing architecture and superb art, for its delightful race of people in their traditional dress, time has stood still in this serene environment. Their unique customs, beliefs and life-style are magical and preserved in its ancient ways.

# PARO FESTIVAL, BHUTAN (11DAYS) LAND COST: US\$

Magnolia and many other spring flowers are blooming and various rare bird species are encountered. Join with the local inhabitants of Paro to celebrate the spring festival, one of the most popular festivals in Bhutan. Monks, as well as laymen dressed in brilliant costumes and wearing masks of both wrathful as well as peaceful deities re-enact the legends and history of Buddhism in the Dragon Kingdom. The festival culminates in the spectacular showing of the four stories 350 years old Thangkha (Buddhist religious scroll), celebrating the deeds of Padmasambhava, who is credited with introducing Buddhism to Bhutan. Locals attend the festival in their finest dresses, beautiful jewelries, and enjoy picnic lunch with abundant of locally brewed alcohol. After the festival, traverse west to east along Bhutan's lateral highway enjoying the great biodiversity, ranging from conifer forest to banana trees and cactus plants. Along the route, enjoy the breath taking views of snow capped mountains, glimpses of various birds and wild animals, and experience the ancient old tradition, culture and Bhutanese way of life.

# JAMBAY LAKHANG FESTIVAL - BHUTAN(10DAYS) LAND COST: US\$



Bumthang is locally known as Jambay Lhakhang Drub. This festival is

held in the picturesque valley of Bumthang in central Bhutan. It gained its popularity from the visits of tourists

in the recent years due to favorable weather. In addition to the mask dances, Jambay Lhakhang built in the year 659 is known for its two special events that is "Mewang" (Fire blessing ceremony). During the fire blessing, locals run underneath a huge flaming gate made out of dry grasses with amber and piles of burning grasses falling on their head. Besides the festival, this trip allows you to enjoy the daily lives of friendly Bhutanese people by visiting villages, temples, monasteries, and gigantic fortresses. It gives you a chance to meet people, enjoy the pristine forest with rare glimpse of wildlife and observe the ancient old traditions of arts and crafts. Begin your trip from Paro Valley and continue by road through the lush valley of Thimphu and to Punakha. Continue the overland journey to the enchanting valleys of Trongsa and Bumthang, which played a key role in influencing Bhutanese history, culture and religion. And then to Phobjikha valley, a winter habitat to the rare black-necked cranes that migrate from Tibetan plateaus in winter. This route will take you through the temperate zone with great biodiversity, ranging from lush forest of conifer, rhododendron and magnolia to orchid draped oaks, banana trees and cactus plants. During clear weather, the high passes you cross, provides spectacular views of high snow capped peaks that go up to 25,000 ft. There will be ample opportunities to interact with the friendly people of Bhutan and learn their philosophy of "GROSS NATIONAL HAPPINESS".
